THE CHALLENGE

Dr. Hall was facing the challenge of insuring that students had the prerequisite knowledge base in key areas at the beginning of the semester. Prior to enrolling in an upper level course, students were expected to have a basic understanding of statistics and experimental design. However, not all students met this expectation due to varied educational backgrounds. Over the years, Dr. Hall was allocating a week or more during a semester to review these areas thereby taking away from valuable class time. Thus, the need was to be able to refresh and evaluate students' knowledge in these areas at the beginning of the semester.

The challenge was to build a set of lessons that included steps in research design, statistical concepts, an introduction to SPSS (a statistical analysis program), and simulations in SPSS. The lessons also needed to be launched through the university's Blackboard environment for easy accessibility by the students.

THE SOLUTION

ToolBook authoring tools, as a solution for the development of this course, helped in providing students with an online review of basic information in the areas of statistics and experimental design. Here the students were presented

If the student made the wrong choice, he or she was then given information on what the correct choice was and why. Once the student had completed the review, he or she was then given the option of taking on an on-line exam or taking an exam over the material in class during the first test.
